Alva Community Council are leading an exercise to involve residents in developing a Community Action Plan (CAPLan) for Alva

- Would you like to see improvements to 'your' area in Alva?
- Do you think Alva needs facilities that could benefit the whole community?

All of these issues were raised by individuals and representatives of community groups at the first CAPLan meeting a few weeks ago.

A Community Action Plan is an analysis of community views and will be presented to Clackmannanshire Council to inform planning processes.

Sauchie and Tullibody town centres are currently being regenerated as part of the 'Village and Small Town Centres Initiative' and Tillicoultry will be next. Would you like Alva to benefit? We are more likely to be considered if the priorities and aspirations of the community are established.

The CAPLan will also provide a mandate for community based action and could assist in applications for funding and support for projects and facilities.
