



Clackmannanshire Council Capital Improvements Grant

This small grant is match funding for the costs of improvements to community-run buildings and land which bring them into more integrated accessible use for local communities

Maximum award : £10,000 for up to 80% of the total project cost

Projects must be

- for buildings or land located within Clackmannanshire Council boundaries and owned or managed by a local community group
- driven by the needs and aspirations of the Clackmannanshire community

The Applicant must

- be a legally constituted, not-for-profit local community group
- own or have responsibility for the maintenance and operation of the halls, other buildings and facilities and or associated land in question on behalf of , and for the use by local communities.

Examples of projects funded through this grant:

- New fencing for local allotments
- Replacement of a flat roof on a community hall
- New disabled access to a community hall
- A community-growing space

Groups who applied in previous financial years are eligible to apply in this financial year. There is no closing date for applications. Applications are considered on a rolling basis and decisions are usually made within 4 weeks.
