APPENDIX I

POLICE REPORT

ALVA COMMUNITY COUNCIL 11/04/2023

INTRODUCTION

The community police officer for Alva is PC 247 James Miller and is stationed at Alloa Police Station, Kilncraigs, Alloa. You can contact him by calling 101 or by e-mail at <u>James.Miller@scotland.police.uk</u>.

Police Scotland recorded 8 incidents of crime in the last month for Alva. Of these, 5 have been detected and the other 3 are currently undetected, all of which are still under investigation.

PRIORITIES

ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

There were 2 recorded incidents of anti-social behaviour in the area over the last month, they were as follows;

On 25th March 2023 at Coblecrook Place, Alva, a male acted in a threatening manner while in possession of a knife. He was arrested and will appear at court on a later date.

On 27th March 2023 at Craighorn Road, Alva, a male was threatening towards another and subsequently arrested. He will appear at court on a later date.

VANDALISM

There were no recorded incidents of vandalism in the area over the last month.

VIOLENCE

There were 5 recorded incidents of violence in the area over the last month, they were as follows;

On 20th March 2023 at Alva Academy, a female pupil assaulted another and was dealt with by the School Based Officer.

On 22nd March 2023 at Queen Street, Alva, a male was assaulted by another. Police are following a positive line of enquiry. On 27th March 2023 at Grodwell Drive, Alva, two persons were assaulted by another who was arrested and will appear at court on a later date.

On 3rd April 2023 at Coblecrook Place, Alva, a female assaulted a male during a domestic incident. The female was arrested and held in custody.

On 9th April 2023 at Caroline Crescent, Alva, several persons were seriously assaulted by two males. Efforts are being made to apprehend those responsible.

ACQUISITIVE CRIME

There was 1 recorded incident of acquisitive crime in the area over the last month, it is as follows;

On 2nd April 2023 at Ochilview, Alva, a quantity of loose change was stolen from an insecure vehicle. No suspect has been identified.

ROAD TRAFFIC

There were no recorded incidents of road traffic offending in the area over the last month.

It should be noted that other traffic offences are routinely detected and dealt with by police without the need for them to be recorded.

OTHER INCIDENTS OF NOTE

Police continue to respond to incidents of youth disorder and anti-social behaviour, in some cases fuelled by the consumption of alcohol. Please do not purchase alcohol for youths and report any concerns regarding the same to the police.

ANY OTHER COMMUNITY ISSUES

The Clackmannanshire Community Team will continue to target local drug dealers utilising intelligence received from the community. This intelligence is essential to enable officers to act against those involved and we encourage any information to be passed to the police or via Crimestoppers.

Enforcement of traffic regulations on Stirling Street, Alva has recommended now that the physical road changes and administration changes are now complete. Please park safely and considerately.
